We have scheduled an introductory meeting to listen to his ideas and plans. Then based on all inputs we got, we presented different options of getting things done at highest level.

After a series of meetings and precisely conceived steps towards teaching, SHL decided to give its trust to our company.

We successfully developed platform and created 11 courses from scratch and online Academy was launched.

Today, the platform they use serves as one of the main resources for educating students who attend the Academy.

Following the successes we have achieved together, SHL has decided to create courses for some of their other projects as well. So far, we have done an additional 8 courses in that area.

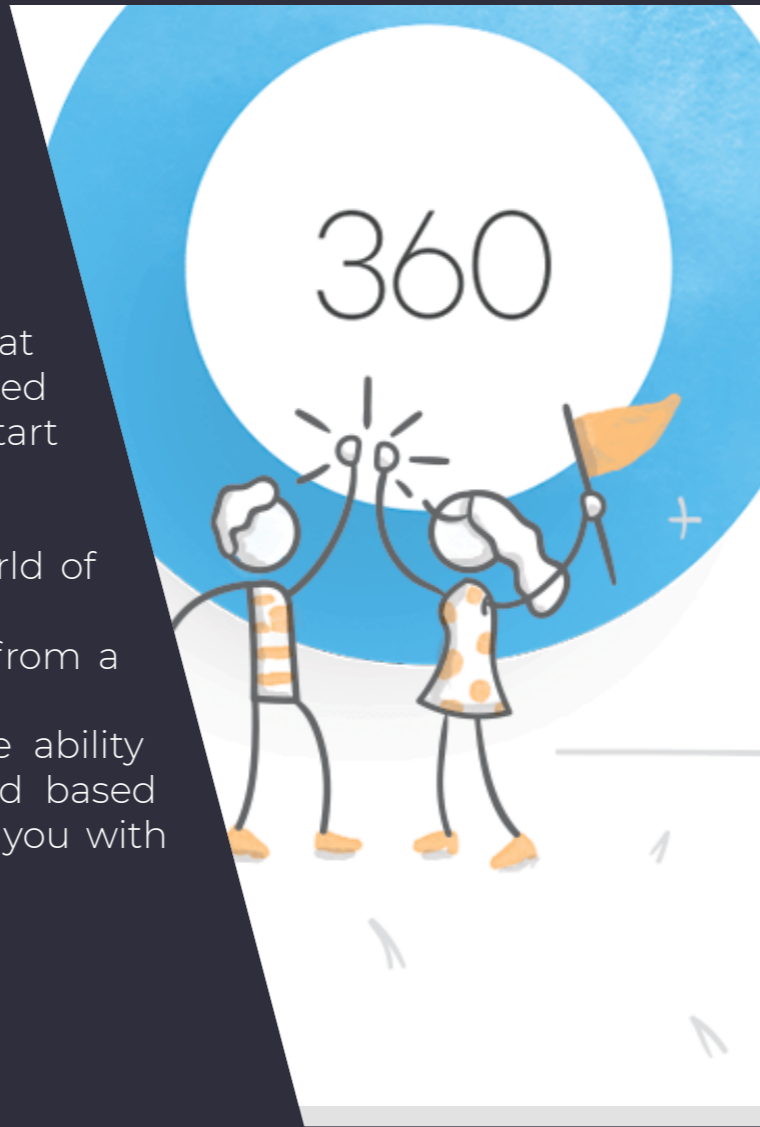

Use case: The Training Terminal





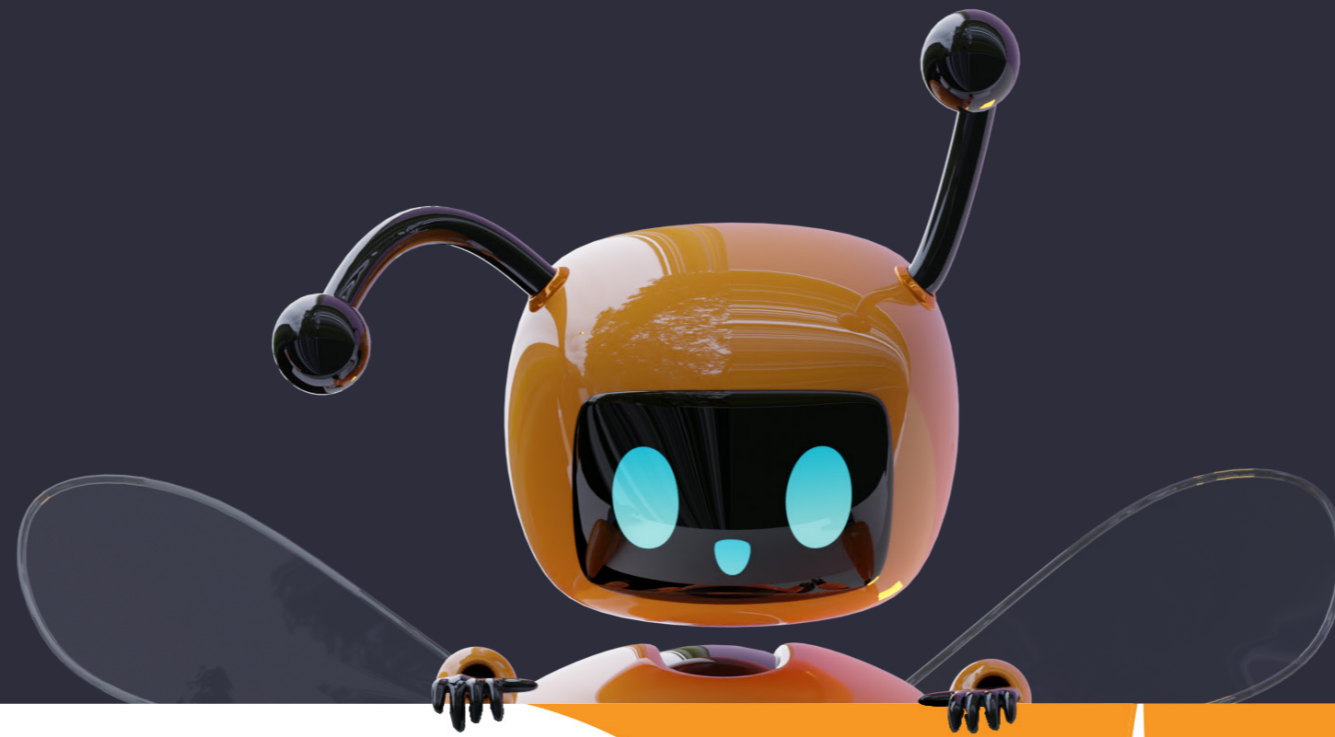
The Training Terminal approached us with a desire to produce courses from the area of hospitality industry.
